Between November and December 2021, an open competition was held for the Executive Director of the American Chamber of Commerce in the Kyrgyz Republic vacant position. The Board of Directors, by the Association's development strategy, had the task to select a candidate who could increase interests representation of the Chamber in the public administration and international level; to increase the number of AmCham members and ensure the loyalty of existing members by providing an opportunity to participate in various discussion forums and platforms to exchange of experience and skills; attracting grants for international projects aimed at business and entrepreneurship development; and presence in the information space of Kyrgyzstan. Thus, to realize the objectives and expand the horizons of the association, there was decided to hire two highly qualified specialists.



Short facts about Dastan Imanaliev:

Before joining the American Chamber of Commerce in the Kyrgyz Republic, **Dastan Imanaliev** starts his rapid career in the International Business Council as a lawyer, then as a Head of the legal support department, and from 2020 as a Deputy Executive Director. His responsibilities included directing the IBC committees' activities, representing IBC in government bodies and other organizations. Dastan Imanaliev coordinated the IBC participation in legislative processes, mainly related to investment promotion, mining, licensing, tax policy, finance, insurance, and telecommunications. In addition, he developed measures to increase the loyalty of IBC existing members and attract new ones.

After graduating from the American University in Central Asia with a bachelor degree in the field of "International and Business Law", Dastan Imanaliev worked as an assistant to a member of Parliament of the Kyrgyz Republic, also assisting to the president/head of the press service in the Foundation for the Management of State Property under the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic, and Lawyer at the State Agency for the Regulation of the Fuel and Energy Complex under the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic.

He participated in projects of international organizations: "Digital Economy in Kyrgyzstan", USAID, 2021; "Club of Economic Journalism", US Embassy in Kyrgyzstan, 2018. "Research on ways of resolving conflict situations in the mining industry of the Kyrgyz Republic", Foundation PisNexus in Central Asia, 2021.

Dastan Imanaliev is a holder of different awards like a certificate of appreciation from Doing Business, The World Bank Group (2021) and a certificate of appreciation from the Ministry of Economy of the Kyrgyz Republic (2019).

Before joining the American Chamber of Commerce in the Kyrgyz Republic **Azamat Oruzbaev** functioned in USAID-BGI projects on tourism development 2017-2018, participated in the Berlin International Tourist Exhibition "ITB Berlin-2018". Initiated the introduction of the "World Nomadic Games" into the UNESCO World Heritage; worked on the project "School Nutrition" in Mercy Coprs Kyrgyzstan, 2018-2019. Joined the USAID-Aga Khan project on development of mountain regions as a mentor since 2021.

Azamat Oruzbayev graduated from the International University of Ala-Too in 2010, specializing in Economics and Management. 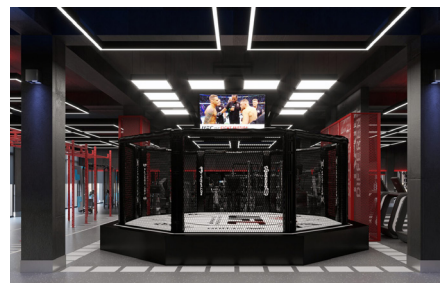
Dastan Imanaliev Met Nuradil Bayasov, Acting Minister of Investments of the Kyrgyz Republic

Tour to UFC GYM Fitness Club



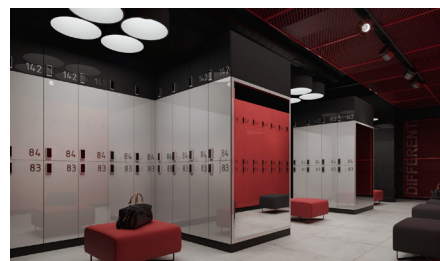
On January 28, 2022, within the framework of the AmCham Company Tours, our members visited the UFC GYM.

The Second Meeting of the Working Group under the Anti-Corruption Business Council of the Kyrgyz Republic



On February 3, 2022, the second meeting of the working group under the Anti-Corruption Business Council of the Kyrgyz Republic was held to discuss the draft strategy “Anti-corruption policy in the Kyrgyz Republic for 2022-2024”.

During the meeting, the parties discussed main principles, approaches and measures to implement the state anti-corruption policy, as well as shared their vision of the content of the above strategy.

The proposed draft of Anti-Corruption Policy Strategy was developed in accordance with the provisions of the concept of the state anti-corruption policy strategy in the Kyrgyz Republic, approved by the resolution of the Anti-Corruption Business Council under the President of the Kyrgyz Republic of November 16, 2021.

Dastan Imanaliev Took Part in the Meeting of Business Representatives with Arzybek Kozhoshev, First Deputy Chairman of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Kyrgyz Republic



On February 4, 2022, the Executive Director of the American Chamber of Commerce in the Kyrgyz Republic, Dastan Imanaliev, took part in the meeting of business representatives with First Deputy Chairman of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Kyrgyz Republic, Arzybek Kozhoshev.

During the meeting Dastan Imanaliev voiced the issue of implementation of labelling of drinking water and beverages in an experimental manner from April 1, 2022 and a full launch from July this year.

Dastan Imanaliev noted that before the launch of these initiatives, it is important for the Cabinet of Ministers of the Kyrgyz Republic to conduct an analysis of the regulatory impact from the implementation of labelling, as well as determine the methodology for selecting product groups to be labeled taking into account the position of manufacturers.

It was also noted that the proposed labelling system imposes excessive obligations on bona fide market participants who even without this system comply with the requirements of the legislation in terms of tax deductions, production of high-quality and safe products.

First Round of Trainings within the Framework of “AmCham Mentors Club” Project



On February 5-6, 2022, a two-day training session was held on the topic “Effective mentoring” for mentees and mentors of the third round of the AmCham Mentors Club program.

The speaker of the training was Zauze Sydykova, a business coach and an expert on building effective communications and personal growth.

Zauze told the participants about the role and functions of the mentor and mentee, tools for building effective mentoring, and about monitoring and evaluation methods. During the training, mentors and mentees participated in teambuilding games and group discussions, which helped participants formulate goals and an effective joint work plan. At the end of the training, participants gained new knowledge about the importance of role and responsibility in achieving program results.



This training is being implemented within the framework of the project “AmCham Mentors Club 3” by the American Chamber of Commerce in the Kyrgyz Republic with the support of the U.S. Embassy in Kyrgyzstan.

Visit of the Business Delegation of the American Chamber of Commerce to the Annual Exhibition of Food Producers “Gulfood Trade Show”



During the period from February 14 to 17, 2022, the business delegation of the American Chamber of Commerce in the Kyrgyz Republic, consisting of representatives of the companies “ABDYSH-ATA” LLC, The Navigator Group, LLC “Forester” and “SUT BULAK” CJSC, as part of the regional initiative AmCham Regional AmCham Network, implemented with the support of the USAID FGI program, visited the annual “Gulfood Trade Show”, held in Dubai (UAE).

“ABDYSH-ATA” is one of the leading manufacturers of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol drinks in the Kyrgyzstan and currently covers 90% of country’s market. The product portfolio includes two main beer brands as TM Zhivoye and Nashe. The portfolio of non-alcoholic products is represented by such brands as fortified carbonated water, kvass, iced teas and soft drinks. The company is exporting its products to Kazakhstan, Russia, Tajikistan, and China.

The Navigator Group is a group of companies, carrying out a number of versatile activities with a single goal of making the lives of urban residents brighter and more interesting! It is a dynamically developing enterprise, whose facilities provide services in various business areas.

LLC “Forester” is one of the largest distribution companies in Kyrgyzstan, which was one of the first in country to start supplying beer from Russia. Today, the main specialization of LLC “Forester” is the distribution of brands of various categories (strong and low-alcohol drinks, juices, power engineers, body care products and personal care products).

“SUT BULAK” CJSC has been producing high-quality cheese and various kinds of dairy products under the Dairy Spring brand for 25 years. “SUT BULAK” is part of the large Swiss cheese company “Spielhofer Swisscheese SA”. The company was formed as a result of the implementation of the intergovernmental Kyrgyz-Swiss Dairy Program. The result of the collective work of consultants from Switzerland and specialists from Kyrgyzstan was the unique cheese factory “SUT BULAK”, which has no analogues in the countries of Central Asia.

The annual Gulfood Trade Show is the largest specialized exhibition in the world and the Persian Gulf and Middle East region. The Gulfood exhibition is particularly popular with visitors from the countries of the region, since more than 95% of food is imported to the Gulf countries, which, along with significant volumes of re-export to the UAE, which are estimated at \$15.8 billion, makes the Gulfood exhibition an important event.

The exhibition was attended by more than 5,000 companies from 120 countries and over 97,000 visitors from 185 countries.

On February 24, 2022, the first online introductory meeting on the Central Asia Regional Expert Level Working Group on Digital Trade was held with members of the American Chamber of Commerce in Kyrgyz Republic. This working group is coordinated by the Commercial Law Development Program (CLDP) of the US Department of Commerce. This is a multilateral group in Central Asia, which will include representatives of the government and the private sector.

During the online meeting, the participants got acquainted with the representatives of CLDP, shared their proposals and voiced issues of interest to promote electronic commerce and digital trade in the country and region.

The goal of the Digital Trade Working Group is to work with stakeholders in the region to develop an open, inclusive, and secure digital infrastructure that will serve as a foundation for regional development and economic growth. The Digital Trade Working Group will seek to fulfill this goal by promoting international best practices, removing digital trade barriers, and fostering the necessary legal and regulatory environment that will allow digital trade to develop and thrive across the region.

Beginning in January 2022, CLDP facilitate a series virtual and in-person roundtables with stakeholder groups in each country in the region, including the Kyrgyz Republic, to identify specific country-level digital trade priorities, challenges, and needs – in preparation for a regional Digital Trade Working Group meeting in Summer 2022.

- Automatic trash box that sorts plastic and glass separately and gives points from special application
- Production of an eco-friendly and safe sanitary pad (napkin) for women
- Utilization of bills from markets and banks and recycling them to paper
- Production of eco-friendly firewood from leaves and sawdust. Reduction of CO2 and affordable energy
- Production of eco benches from plastic

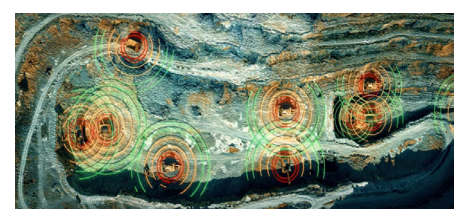
