Webber Air Cargo is an Austin, Texas-based corporation that principally provides cargo-related airport planning services. Michael Webber, the company's president,

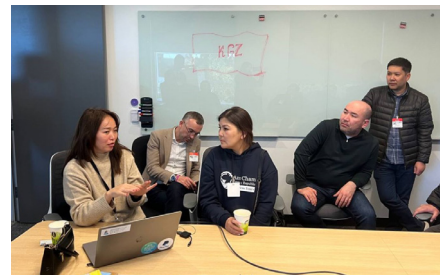


spoke about his corporation.

On November 18, 2022, the first Gender Bonds were launched in a public auction ceremony. A total of 82,000 bonds, valued at 1,000 soms each with a total issuance of 82,000,000 soms. The term of circulation is 3 years.

The sale of the Gender Bonds was met with strong demand, with bids for 25% of the bonds being received within the first half hour. These bonds were mainly purchased by the private sector, with prominent investors including the Accumulative Pension Fund Kyrgyzstan, Bank of Asia shareholder Lee Jong Bek, businessman Jumabek Salymbekov, World Class Bishkek CEO Nadira Kasymova, Jubilee Kyrgyzstan insurance company, and the Dordoi Association.

The Bank of Asia played a significant role in the launch of these Gender Bonds as the first bank-issuer of gender bonds under the program of targeted sustainable development and implementation of ESG components. The goal of these gender bonds is to raise awareness about gender inequality and to empower women, including economically. AUCA constructs a new building for the National Academy of Sciences of Kyrgyzstan

The American University of Central Asia and the Institute of Seismology of the National Academy of Sciences of the Kyrgyz Republic are together building the basis for enhanced opportunities for successful cooperation in research. The two institutions created, in 2018, a consortium with the aim to improve the seismic safety in Kyrgyzstan and other Central Asian countries through interdisciplinary research and consulting in seismology, urbanism and sustainable development. Combining the research potential of these two well-respected institutions will improve the quality of life of our citizens through improved planning, construction, and provision of vital services of cities.



The Tien Shan mountains are characterized by high seismological activity. More than 5,000 earthquakes are registered every year, 7-9 of which are strong with a magnitude of 4.5 or more. Seismic monitoring is one of the most critical tasks in the region. The Institute of Seismology of the Kyrgyz Republic assesses the seismic risk in the area of Kyrgyzstan and Central Asia. The Institute's staff is continuously working on compiling earthquake catalogs, conducting macroseismic surveys of the effects of earthquakes, and developing recommendations for reducing social, economic, and environmental damage from earthquakes.

Adequate infrastructure and comfortable working conditions are required for this research activity. Unfortunately, the current facility of the Institute of Seismology, erected in the 1980s, has hardly been repaired since it was built due to the lack of funds and has gradually fallen into disrepair. Due to obsolete communications and the lack of a heating system, the operation of the building has become challenging, especially in winter. The construction of a new, modern building for the Institute of Seismology became a strategically important matter for the region.

At the end of 2018, within the framework of consortium between AUCA and the Institute of Seismology, the American University of Central Asia received by the decision of the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic a portion of the territory of the Institute of Seismology for the construction of research and educational facilities. AUCA also committed to build a new building for the Institute of Seismology. The construction project is fully funded by AUCA thanks to the support of the Open Society Foundations.

After completion of the construction, which is currently well underway, the Institute of Seismology will take possession of a modern, two-story building (with a basement), built for its intended use as a headquarters and research hub.

The President of the National Academy of Sciences of the Kyrgyz Republic Kanatbek Abdrakhmatov is enthusiastic about the cooperation with AUCA, "Cooperation with AUCA is a great opportunity for us. Over the past 30 years, not a single new building has been built for the National Academy of Sciences. Thanks to the cooperation with AUCA, we will receive a new building. In this building, in addition to our own research, we will conduct joint research projects with AUCA".



Jonathan Becker, AUCA Acting President and Bard College Vice-President, is enthusiastic about the project, "We are thrilled to see this project moving forward. We believe it will contribute to new and outstanding research opportunities and much improved conditions for the Institute of Seismology and tremendous opportunities for future cooperation between AUCA and the National Academy of Sciences. Such cooperative activities are tremendously rewarding for both institutions and for the future of the Kyrgyz Republic".

The cooperation between the American University of Central Asia and the Institute of Seismology will help to bring the learning and research capacity of both institutions to a higher level, and lay a solid foundation for joint interdisciplinary projects aimed at improving the quality of life in Kyrgyzstan and larger in Central Asia.



"We are delighted to be working closely with the National Academy of Sciences of Kyrgyzstan on this important project," said David Lakh-dhir, the Chairman of the Board of Trustees of AUCA. "Not only will this provide the Seismological Institute with a new, purpose-built home, but it will facilitate opportunities for future research collaboration between the University and the Institute of Seismology in service of the needs and interests of the Kyrgyz nation".

According to the AUCA Vice-President and Chief Operating Officer Chyngyz Shamshiev, who is leading the cooperation between AUCA and the Institute of Seismology, "The staff of the Institute will be finally able to work in comfortable and decent conditions. For the first time in the history of the independent Kyrgyzstan, the National Academy of Sciences will have a brand-new building. The cooperation between AUCA and the Institute of Seismology is the very first and excellent example of an efficient not-for-profit research-oriented public-private partnership for the benefit of the Kyrgyz science and citizens".

The construction of a new administrative building is in full swing. All floors, engineering networks, and windows blocks have already been erected. The finishing works are underway. It is planned to put the building into service in spring 2023.

AUCA, Bard College, and USAID are pleased to announce the commencement of construction of the Makerspace AUCA Learning and Design Center



The project, which is funded by AUCA, Bard College, and the United States Agency for International Development (USAID), will result in the establishment on AUCA's Bishkek campus of an educational, creative and entrepreneurial space, where high-tech equipment for the design and production of prototypes of innovative products will be available for use, both by AUCA students and by others in the wider community.

AUCA's Makerspace Learning and Design Center will be open to AUCA's students and faculty, and also to scientists, engineers, start-up entrepreneurs, and developers from all over Kyrgyzstan. All will be able to use the Makerspace and its high-tech equipment for communication, learning, exchange of ideas, prototyping and even attracting investors.

To allow innovators to bring their ideas to life, the Makerspace will be equipped with a workshop with special equipment (3D printers, laser cutters, robotics kits, sewing machines) and a computer laboratory with powerful graphics stations. It will also have "brainstorming" rooms, learning rooms, a large conference room, and spaces for communication and individual work. The equipment in the Makerspace AUCA Learning and Design Center, which would be too expensive to be affordable by an individual innovator, will thus be accessible to students, inventors, entrepreneurs and other innovators, due to collective and shared use.

"The Makerspace project represents an exciting opportunity for the University, as host to such an innovative design space, for its students, who will be able to profit from the hands-on learning experiences, it will facilitate, and for the wider Kyrgyz community, whose creativity and economic dynamism the Center is designed to promote," said David Lakhdir, the Chairman of AUCA's Board of Trustees.

Jonathan Becker, the Vice-President of Bard College and Acting President of AUCA, says:

"We are thrilled that we are moving forward with the AUCA Makerspace and very thankful to USAID and ASHA for their support. We view this as a part of our efforts to ensure that AUCA is contributing actively to the development of Kyrgyzstan and look forward to when it opens and people from across the country come there to develop new ideas".

According to Chingiz Shamshiev, the AUCA Vice President and Chief Operating Officer, who conceived of and has brought the Makerspace project to fruition, AUCA Makerspace will help young people overcome personal and social obstacles to their growth, which will contribute to the creation of a more cohesive, tolerant, and, at the same time, diverse and collaborative society. The community of makers should not be divided by national, religious, and other characteristics. Makers are united by the desire to create new things and invent and implement ideas.

Dr. Shamshiev also commented on the project's desire to contribute to the creation of a more equitable and prosperous society. *"Technologies should not be the lot of the chosen ones, who use them to preserve their privileged position,"* he said. *"Ordinary citizens should have access to modern technologies, and the ability to use them in the interests of a more prosperous, fair and free society. Makerspace AUCA is designed to contribute to the emergence of free people"*.

The makerspace building will be located a few dozen meters from the main campus of the AUCA. The project of the building was developed by the Kyrgyz architectural design company "Archidea" and approved by USAID. The Kyrgyz company "Karmis", which has considerable experience in the construction of multi-story administrative and educational buildings, was selected as the general contractor for the construction following an open tender. The building will be constructed following modern requirements of energy efficiency, and environmental and climate safety. It will also meet the needs of

people with disabilities.

The AUCA Makerspace Learning and Design Center will open opportunities for people from different parts of society, including women, people with disabilities, people from low-income families, and other groups who would not otherwise have access to technology.

The term "makerspace" was coined in 2005. The concept sought to combine the popular concept of "Do it Yourself" innovation with the potential for harnessing high technologies. Recently, the concept of makerspace began to denote a social movement that seeks to popularize technological innovations, make them more accessible to a wide range of people, and thereby allow ordinary people to be innovators and entrepreneurs. The democratization of technologies based on the makerspace principle makes it possible to bring technologies and society closer together, and increase the chances that technologies will be used to solve the problems of the general population and improve their standard of living.
